RE: Parents' Right to Know

Under the regulations of the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) signed into law on January 8, 2002, parents have the right to request professional qualifications of their child's teacher (s) and paraprofessional(s) who provide instruction to their child. You have the right to ask for the following information:

- Whether Pennsylvania has licensed the teacher for the grades and subjects he/she teaches
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which Pennsylvania licensing criteria have been waived
- The teacher's baccalaureate degree major and whether the teacher has any advanced degrees, and if so, the subject of the degrees
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications

We are pleased to report that at the present time, all of the Eastern Lebanon County School District professional employees meet the highly-qualified status of their assigned grade level and/or subject area. If you would like to receive specific information about your child's teacher or paraprofessional, please contact your school principal.
